WRISTBAND COLLECTION

All guests need a festival wristband to enter the site. Tickets can only be exchanged for a wristband on the date that your entry is valid for, no wristbands will be issued early. Photo ID is required to verify all tickets. You

can exchange your Festival No.6 ticket for a wristband at the Park & Ride or Bangor Train Station.

VIP ACCESS

If you are a VIP guest, you have exclusive access to the Hotel Portmeirion and Castell Deudraeth.

TRAVEL

ARRIVING BY CAR

There is no onsite parking at No.6. All vehicles must head to the Park & Ride on arrival. If you have not already purchased your Park & Ride tickets online you can add them to your booking via your online dashboard, or purchase them on arrival for £25 per car (cash only). It is a 15 minute journey to Portmeirion via our free and frequent shuttle service. If you haven't yet planned your car journey,

ARRIVING BY TAXI

Please do not direct your Taxi to the festival site as no vehicles will be granted access. Please direct your taxi to the Park & Ride where you will be able to collect your wristband and board the free shuttle service to the heart of the festival.

ARRIVING BY TRAIN

If you have purchased a Virgin Trains ticket via Festival No.6, you will receive this separately in the post from Virgin Trains. Our team will be on board your train to exchange your ticket for a wristband. Exclusive No.6 shuttle buses will be provided from Bangor train station to the heart of the festival site. We strongly suggest that you book this in advance, however you can purchase on arrival (subject to availability). To book your shuttle, please log in to your online dashboard. *Please note if you are arriving or departing on Saturday or Sunday, there are no shuttles to and from Bangor. Please make your own way to the Park & Ride to exchange your wristband.

ARRIVING BY BIG GREEN COACH

If you have purchased a Big Green Coach return journey, your tickets will be in this wallet. Your departure times and location are printed on this ticket. Please ensure you keep your ticket safe for your return journey and allow yourself 30 minutes prior to your departure time to board the coach.

ARRIVING BY CAMPERVAN

If you have pre-purchased a Campervan ticket, please head towards the Park & Ride and follow signs for the Campervan Entrance, where you will exchange your tickets for wristbands. Pitches that have been pre-purchased are 5mx5m. Water and electrical hook ups are not available. Campervans must be specific camper adapted vehicles and must not be towed. Please do not attempt to bring your campervan unless you have pre-purchased a campervan ticket.

ACCOMMODATION

GENERAL CAMPSITE SERVICES

There are many shower and toilet facilities available free of charge in the general and family campsite areas, however if you wish to add a touch more luxury to your weekend, you can purchase a Zooloos Powder Rooms pass in advance or at the festival. There are a number of food vendors in the campsite, as well as a shop for food and camping provisions.

BOUTIQUE CAMPING VILLAGE

If you have pre-purchased Boutique Camping, please ensure you step off the shuttle at the Boutique Camping Reception stop and check-in to exchange your boutique ticket for your boutique wristband and be shown to your accommodation. Upon checking-in to your accommodation, the lead booker will be asked to sign T&C's and to supply credit card details so we can pre-authorise a security deposit of £75, just like when you check into a hotel. The

amount isn't debited, it's only held in transit, in case damages occur or items are missing.

PITCH VILLAGE

If you have pre-purchased Pitch Village, please ensure you step off the shuttle at the Castell Deudraeth. You will receive more information on PV via email shortly.

PORTMEIRION ACCOMMODATION

If you have booked accommodation in Portmeirion Village or Castell Deudraeth, you will be emailed detailed arrival information from Portmeirion directly. For the first time, this year, you can extend your stay in Portmeirion Village, either side of the festival dates, at a reduced rate. Call Portmeirion direct on 01766 770000 to book.

EXTRAS

THE ESTUARY SPA

WOOD-FIRED HOT TUB SESSIONS

If you have pre-purchased a Hot Tub Session at the Estuary Spa, you will have received confirmation from our spa partner, Kernow Springs. Please arrive 5 minutes prior to your session. If you would like to add a Hot Tub session, please click [here](#) or head to the Information Hub in the Village Green.

YOGA

If you have pre-purchased a paddle-boarding session for morning yoga, you will have received an e-ticket.

PADDLE-BOARDING

If you have pre-purchased a paddle-boarding session on the estuary, you will have received an e-ticket. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your session with your swimwear on. You will be given a wetsuit and life jacket.

DINNER AT CLOUGH'S

If you have pre-purchased Dinner at Clough's, please ensure you arrive with your party at Hotel Portmeirion 5 minutes prior to your sitting. Please bring your Dinner at Clough's e-ticket along in order to confirm your table reservation. If you have any special dietary requirements please let our customer service team know before you arrive at the festival. If you are booking a table with your friends but under separate booking references, please contact Customer Service and we will do our very best to seat you together. (Please note we cannot guarantee this).

PROGRAMMES & MERCHANDISE

If you pre-purchased a festival programme, you can collect it from any of the merchandise points on site or from the Information Hub in the Village Green. You will need your programme ticket in order to exchange it. You can purchase programmes and festival merchandise from our three merchandise points in the Castell Park, Village Green and P&R.

WORKSHOPS AND ACTIVITIES

If you have signed up in advance to take part in the Torchlit Processions, Carnival No.6 or The Guardian Masterclasses at the No.6 Academy, you will be emailed on the 1st September to let you know if you have been successful. If you haven't received confirmation in advance, we hold back a small allocation on site, so please register your interest at the Information Hub. They will be able to tell you where and when you can sign up.

GENERAL INFO & FACILITIES

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Glass, Fires, Dogs (with the exception of Guide Dogs), Illegal substances, Fireworks, Air Horns, Flying Lanterns, Flares, Soundsystems, Disposable BBQs (if you are bringing a gas BBQ, please ensure the gas canister does not exceed the size of 500g).

ALCOHOL

There is a limit on the amount of alcohol allowed to be taken into the festival. Alcohol cannot be taken from the campsite into the arena or village. The personal alcohol limit is: 1 bottle of spirits (decanted) OR 1 case of 12 beers OR 2 bottles of wine (decanted). Bars will be operating a challenge 25 policy, and you may be asked for I.D. Please do not be offended if you are asked to prove your age.

SAFETY & WELFARE

Full emergency services will be present at the festival. We have a Welfare & First Aid point located in the campsite services area. Please don't hesitate to ask for help from a steward or security team member should you require assistance.

RUBBISH & RECYCLING

Portmeirion is a beautiful home for our festival, and we want to do our utmost to ensure it stays as beautiful as we found it. Please utilise the bins and recycling points available on site. Please take your tents and camping equipment with you when you leave, the best way to recycle is to reuse.

LOST PROPERTY

Any lost property handed in will be taken to the Information Hub in the Village Green (see site map). After the festival you can contact us to see if your property was found by contacting Customer Services with the subject header 'Lost Property' and your name and we will do our best to try and reunite you with your property.

PAYMENT ON SITE

We operate both cash and contactless card payments on site. There are cash machines on site for you to withdraw cash. Please note the cash machines are not accessible on Thursday.

FOOD & DRINK

As well as two restaurants, we have over 60 of the UK's finest food and drink traders at the festival within our Global Street Food Village and our Local Produce Market and over 25 bars.

LOCKERS AND PHONE CHARGING

If you wish to lock any valuable items away, you can do so in our secure lockers located in the Village Green. You can also benefit from our phone charging facilities, as well as purchase essential camping kits.
