## ADD EXTRAS TO YOUR BOOKING

If you wish to add any Travel, Boutique Camping, pre-erected Pitch Village tents or Extras such as Dinner At Clough's, Hot Tubs, Yoga and Paddle Boarding, you can do so by booking at [festivalnumber6.com/tickets](http://festivalnumber6.com/tickets). You will receive an e-ticket for added extras via email. Ensure you print this out to be scanned at the event or download it to your phone. If you wish to purchase any extras at the festival, head to the Information Hub in the Village Green. Please note you can not purchase Boutique Camping or Pitch Village at the festival.

## WRISTBAND COLLECTION

All guests need a festival wristband to enter the festival. Tickets can only be exchanged for a wristband on the date that your ticket entry is valid for, no wristbands will be issued early. Photo ID is required to verify all tickets.

**Portmeirion Entrance:** If you are camping within the Access Campsite and dropping off your luggage and party members, you'll be able to collect your wristbands at the entrance to Portmeirion.

**Park & Ride:** If you are parking in Standard Parking and/or not staying in the Access Campsite, then you will need to collect your wristbands from the Park & Ride wristband exchange.

If you have requested access to the viewing platform and/or the stewarded toilets, please collect your wristbands at the Access Reception located in the Access Camping, by the Castell Deudraeth.

### ARRIVING BY CAR

There is no onsite parking at No.6. Please read the below on where to collect your parking pass.

- If you are camping in the Access Campsite and have requested a parking pass, collect this from the access steward at the entrance to

Portmeirion when you arrive to unload your luggage. Please note you will only be allowed temporary access before driving it to the Porthmadog Rugby Club.

- If you are visiting for the day or staying anywhere other than the Access Campsite, but have requested Accessible Parking, please head to the Rugby Club.

A regular shuttle bus service will be available to transfer you from Porthmadog Rugby Club to Portmeirion (timings will be emailed to you soon). Please contact [access@festivalnumber6.com](mailto:access@festivalnumber6.com) if you require a wheelchair accessible escort to and from the festival.

- If you have not requested accessible parking, please ensure you book your Park & Ride tickets from [festivalnumber6.com/tickets](http://festivalnumber6.com/tickets), or purchase them on arrival for £25 per car (cash only). It is a 15 minute journey to Portmeirion via our free and frequent shuttle service.

## ARRIVING BY CAMPERVAN

Access Campervan Pitch: If you have been approved for an accessible campervan pitch then please arrive at Portmeirion Entrance to collect your wristbands. From here you will be directed to your campervan pitch in the Access Campsite. These pitches are limited and sold out. Please do not arrive at this entrance if you have not been pre-approved via your Access Application.

General Campervan Pitch: If you have pre-purchased a campervan ticket, please head to Porthmadog Rugby Club to exchange your festival ticket for your wristband and then follow signs for the campervan entrance. Please note, Porthmadog Rugby Club is only open Thursday & Friday and you will need to go to Minffordd Box Office if you arriving on Saturday or Sunday.

Festival tickets need to be exchanged for wristbands before driving to the campervan field. Water and electrical hook ups are not available. Campervans must be purpose-built camper vehicles and must not be towed. Campervan pitches have sold out, please do not bring your vehicle if you haven't pre-purchased a ticket.

## ACCOMMODATION

### GENERAL CAMPSITE SERVICES

There are shower and toilet facilities available free of charge in the general and family campsite areas. When you arrive, you can purchase luxury shower and toilet facilities to use in the Campsite Green. There are a number of food vendors in the campsite, as well as a shop for food and camping provisions.

### MEDICAL EQUIPMENT: POWER

If you require any power for necessary medical equipment i.e. CPAP machine, please contact [access@festivalnumber6.com](mailto:access@festivalnumber6.com) to request this facility in advance. Please note that any electric hook up provided by No.6 is from a temporary power source and 100% up time cannot be guaranteed.

### BOUTIQUE CAMPING VILLAGE

If you have purchased Boutique Camping, please ensure you step off the shuttle at the Boutique Camping Reception stop and check-in to exchange your boutique ticket for your boutique wristband.

### PITCH VILLAGE

If you have purchased Pitch Village, please ensure you step off the shuttle at Castell Deudraeth. You will receive more arrival information via email from Pitch Village.

### PORTMEIRION ACCOMMODATION

If you have booked accommodation in Portmeirion Village or Castell Deudraeth, you will be emailed detailed arrival information.

## EXTRAS

### WOOD-FIRED HOT TUB SESSIONS

If you have pre-purchased a wood-fired hot tub session at the Estuary Spa, you will have

received confirmation from Bathing Under the Sky. Please arrive 5 minutes prior to your session. If you would like to add a Hot Tub session, please visit [festivalnumber6.com/tickets](http://festivalnumber6.com/tickets) or head to the Information Hub.

### DINNER AT CLOUGH'S

If you have booked Dinner at Clough's, please ensure you arrive with your party at Hotel Portmeirion 15 minutes prior to your sitting, with your ticket. If you have any special dietary requirements please let our customer service team know before you arrive at the festival. If you are booking with your friends but under separate booking references, please contact Customer Service and we will do our very best to seat you together. (Please note we cannot guarantee this). ### PADDLE-BOARDING

If you have pre-purchased a paddle-boarding session on the estuary, you will have received an e-ticket. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your session with your swimwear on. You will be given a life jacket.

### PROGRAMMES & MERCHANDISE

If you pre-purchased the No.6 x Wallpaper\* Festival Guide programme, you can collect it from any of the merchandise points at the festival or from the Information Hub. You will need your programme ticket in order to exchange it. You can purchase programmes and festival merchandise from the Castell Park, Village Green. [Book your programme in advance here.](#)

### WORKSHOPS AND ACTIVITIES

If you have applied in advance to take part in the Torchlit Processions, Stealing Sheep's Suffragette Procession or The Guardian Masterclasses and you are successful, you will be notified via email. Look out for masterclasses from Peroni ([you book this in advance here](#)), Zubrowka & Schweppes across the weekend.

## GENERAL INFO & FACILITIES

### PROHIBITED ITEMS

This list includes but is not limited to: Glass, Fires, Dogs (with the exception of Guide Dogs), Illegal substances, Fireworks, Air Horns, Flying Lanterns, Flares, Soundsystems, Disposable BBQs (if you are bringing a gas BBQ, please note a maximum of three gas canisters will be permitted per tent, with max. canister size of 500g/ml and a combined capacity of no more than 1000g/ml overall).

### ALCOHOL

Alcohol cannot be taken from the campsite into the arena or Portmeirion village and there is a limit on the amount of alcohol that may be brought into the festival and campsites.

The personal alcohol limit is: 1 bottle of spirits (decanted) OR 1 case of 12 beers OR 2 bottles of wine (decanted). Bars will be operating a challenge 25 policy, and you may be asked for I.D. Please do not be offended if you are asked to prove your age.

### RUBBISH & RECYCLING

Portmeirion is a beautiful home for our festival, and we want to do our utmost to ensure it stays as beautiful as we found it. As part of AIF's #DrasticOnPlastic campaign, we ask that you utilise the bins and recycling points available at the festival and take your rubbish with you when you leave. The best way to recycle is to reuse.

### FOOD & DRINK

As well as two restaurants, we have over 40 of the UK's finest food and drink traders at the festival within our Global Street Food Village and our Local Produce Market and over 25 bars.

### LOST PROPERTY

Any lost property handed in will be taken to the Information Hub in the Village Green. If you don't manage to retrieve it during the festival, you can contact us after to see if your property was found by contacting [customerservice@festivalnumber6.com](mailto:customerservice@festivalnumber6.com).

### PAYMENT AT THE FESTIVAL

We operate both cash and contactless card payments at every bar and most traders. There are cash machines to withdraw cash, however, we recommend bringing an adequate amount of cash to cover you. Please note the cash machines are not accessible on Thursday.

### LOCKERS AND PHONE CHARGING

If you wish to lock any valuable items away, you can book a secure lockers at the festival. You can also benefit from our phone charging facilities, based in the Village Green.
